- The official results reflected a timing glitch, as Tinney was credited with a 9:08.71, which would have put him just inches behind Voss at the finish. In actuality, he was 35-40m back according to the author's recollection and other witnesses, including the winner. It appeared that the Tinney 9:08.71 was a phantom time, and all the times behind the winner were offset by one place.
