In its first year, the 4 x 110-yard relay was the meet's final event. Flint Northwestern was ahead at the final exchange, in position to win the team title by a half-point, when the baton dropped. According to the *Flint Journal*, "In exchanging the baton, Tim Davis and Odell Hall got fouled up and the Wildcats were finished. Neither should be faulted. At that point they needed a perfect exchange to win the title and didn't get it. Even if they had exchanged perfectly, there's no guarantee that Hall could have held off Oak Park anchorman Mike Rollins. Rollins had already finished second in the 100 so he had a clear edge in ability."
