

HIGH SCHOOL FIELD DAY.

Sports at the D. A. C. Grounds May
31—124 Entries.

The field day this year of the Detroit high school athletic association is set for Saturday, May 31, on the D. A. C. grounds. The events begin sharply at 2 p. m. The entry list, which closed last Friday, is the largest the association ever had, there being 124 entries in all. The all-around medal will be sharply contested for. The way in which the D. H.
