

## ATHLETIC CONTESTS

At the Y. M. C. A. Gymnasium Last Evening.

The Y. M. C. A. gymnasium contests last evening were very interesting and participated in by a number of the members under the direction of Physical Instructor George H. Williamson. The question to be decided was who was the best jumper, the first contest being on vaulting the bar, in which Fred Dean vaulted 6 feet 2 inches, Fred Saunders coming next with 5 feet 10 inches. Then came the standing broad jump without weights, in which Fred Dean came again to the front, jumping 9 feet 10 inches, J. H. Fraust being second with a score of 9 feet  $2\frac{1}{2}$  inches to his credit. Fred Dean also won the standing high jump, 4 feet 1 inch being his record, Sill Hamilton second with 3 feet 11 inches for his showing. Louis Quinnin won the running high jump, 4 feet 7 inches being scored, Chas. Temple coming in second by 4 feet 6 inches.

The Indian club race was an amusing and heartily enjoyed feature of the evening, and consisted in seven Indian clubs being placed on one side of the hall, the object being to take a club, run and touch the opposite wall, return and restore the club. Frank Smith came off victor. The gymnasium is in a high state of proficiency and great credit is due Prof. Williamson for the manner in which he conducts this feature of the association.
