Running Broad Jump—Fred Clark, 14 feet, 6½ inches.

Running High Jump—Coffin, 5 feet, 2 inches.

Four Mile Race—Stewart White, 28 minutes, 17 seconds.

One Mile Race—Cutler, 6 minutes, 28 2-5 seconds.

Standing Hop, Step and Jump—Coffin, 27 feet, 6½ inches.

Sack Race—Geo. Widdicomb, 18 seconds.
