The High School Field Day.

The Detroit High School Athletic Association hold their sixth annual field day next Friday afternoon on the D. A. C. grounds. These games have been from the first meeting of great interest to those connected with the school and the friends of the school. The games have always been among the first, if not the first, in the city, and on this account, as well as the high standard of the contests, have attracted considerable attention. This year's field day will equal in every way those of former years. Already the High School has records which have not been equaled by any other high school in the country, and many of the leading colleges have records far below those of the High school boys. The record of the High School in the pole vault, half mile hurdles, 100 yard dash and one mile run are especially to be admired. This year the running high jump will certainly be the contest of the day, and from the entries it will be one that will be a record maker for the school. The one that wins will have to clear close to 5 feet 6 inches, as there are several of the boys who jump more than five feet. The hurdles will probably be the prettiest race on the track as Thrall, the expected winner, and the winner of the 100 yd. hurdle in their spring hold day, will be closely pushed.
