

HIGH SCHOOL GAMES.

Sixth Annual Field Day Events and Winners.

The sixth annual field day games of the Detroit high school were held at the D. A. C. grounds yesterday afternoon and were well attended. John S. Sweeney was referee, A. G. Studer, Charles Annesley and Prof. H. C. Adams judges, Al Strachan, Will Gregg and Keene Fitzpatrick timers, and M. C. Murphy starter. The best all round work was done by F. Werbeck, but Thrall's hurdle jumping and Walker's bicycle riding were commendable. The winners of the different events were as follows:

100 yards—First heat: H. Keep (3 yds), won; A. Gage (2½ yds), second; F. Thrall (scratch), third; time, 11 seconds. Second heat: D. Beath (scratch), won; A. Peppers (5 yds), second; F. Field (1½ yds), third; time, 11 1-5 seconds. Final heat: H. Keep won, D. Beath second, A. Peppers third; time, 11 seconds.

220-yards dash—F. Thrall (scratch), won; D. Beath (2 yds), second; C. Barton (5 yds), third; time, 24 4-5 seconds.

440-yards run—F. Werbeck (scratch), won; C. Foster (scratch), second; time, 57½ seconds.

880-yards run—C. Foster (scratch) won; A. P. Peppers (25 yds), second; time, 2:17 3-5.

One-mile run—W. Kinmont (40 yds) won; W. H. Gage (scratch) second; H. Dean (15 yds) third; time, 5:07½.

120-yards hurdle—F. Thrall (6 yds penalty) won; H. Keep (5 yds penalty) second; K. B. Alexander (scratch) third; time, 17 4-5 seconds.

Quarter-mile walk—A. P. Peppers (20 yds) won; F. Thrall (scratch) second; time, 1:43.

One-mile bicycle—E. W. Walker (scratch) won; B. Foster (30 yds) second; A. Zacharias (scratch) third; time, 2:55½.

Running high jump—A. K. Gage (1 in.), 5 ft. 4 in.; H. Keep (scratch), 5 ft. 8 in.; K. B. Alexander (6 in.), 4 ft. 8½ in.
