ATHLETICS.

Tilt Won the Y. M. C. A. Medal.

The season of winter athletic contests given by the Y. M. C. A. was closed last evening before a large audience of young and old people. The games were conducted by A. G. Studer, physical director of the association.

The feature of the evening was the performance of Louis Kirchner, who won in all events. At the close of the last contest he had but eight points. To these he added thirty-one points last evening, tying him with George N. Herring for second place in the final. The latter had twenty-eight points at the close of the last contest, while J. A. Tilt had twenty-six. The latter added fourteen points to this last evening and won the gold medal for the highest all-round score.

Herring won the pole vault with 81-2 feet, Kirchner second with 81-4.

Kirchner won the running high jump with 51-2 feet, breaking the Detroit association indoor record by 1 inch. Tilt was second with 5 feet 2 inches.

Kirchner won the 100-yard club race in 201-5 seconds, one-fifth second better than the association record; Harry Mera second.

The 15-yard dash was won by Tilt, J. M. Marker second.

Kirchner won the running high kick with 8 feet 2 inches; D. A. Slemmer second with 8 feet.

Herring and P. Wohlfeider won the German wrestling match, Tilt and Kirchner second.

Kirchner won the standing broad jump with 9 feet 21-4 inches; Tilt second with 9 feet.

The 12-pound shot put was won by Kirchner with 35 feet 41-2 inches; Wohlfeider second with 33 feet 61-2 inches.

On Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday next the junior, intermediate and senior classes, in the dates and order named, will be examined for prizes. The work will be done on the parallel bar, horse, horizontal bar, standing broad jump, running high jump, running high kick and vaulting bar. The senior and intermediate classes will substitute shot-putting for the kick. To the prize winner in the senior class a gold medal will be given; intermediate, silver; junior, bronze.
