Pole vault—N. P. Mera, 9-5, breaking the record of S. D. formerly held by George Herring; Herring, 9-3; Kirchner, 9 feet.

15-yard dash—Acheson first, Louis Pleis second, J. Nolde third.

100-yard potato race—Acheson first, O. J. Wallick second, W. Y. Ruthard third.

Indian club race—F. M. Shimick first, Wallick second, Kirchner third.
