

## HIGH SCHOOL FIELD DAY.

The Lads Have Some Very Interesting Athletic Games.

The results of the semi-annual field day held Saturday afternoon at Comstock park under the auspices of the Grand Rapids High school Athletic club were in every way very satisfactory. As a school social event it was a pretty success and the board of managers realized a good sum from the gate receipts.

Some of the records made were not particularly brilliant. The list of events and winners is as follows: 100-yard dash, Charles Stewart, 17 $\frac{1}{4}$  seconds; putting shot, Charles Bradford, 28 ft. 5 in.; quarter mile walk, B. L. Bartlett, 1:50; 75-yard three-legged race, P. Weston and G. Dayrell, 13 seconds; standing broad jump, Paul Weston, 9 ft. 9 $\frac{1}{2}$  in.; one mile bicycle race, Lloyd Phelps, 2:17; one mile run, Charles Stewart, 5:35 $\frac{1}{2}$ ; 12-pound hammer, Paul Gibson, 72 ft. 8 in.; 220-yard dash, Guy Dayrell, 25 $\frac{1}{4}$  seconds; baton swinging, P. Heath; one-mile walk, B. L. Bartlett, 10:01; 110-yard dash, Charles Stewart, 56 $\frac{1}{4}$  seconds.

On the broad jump Weston lowered the school record one inch and Phelps brought down the one mile bicycle record, formerly held by J. A. Clark, now at Purdue university, four seconds.
