The half-mile bicycle race was won by Staufflett, Ann Arbor; Bush, Battle Creek, second; Turner, Lansing, third, and Dodsley, Ann Arbor, fourth; time, 1:14.

440-yard dash—Christopher, of Lansing, won, 57 2-5 seconds.

Pole vault—Christopher, of Lansing, won, 8 feet 3 inches; Eddy, of Jackson, second; Leshner, of Lansing, third.

Running high jump—Gibson, of Grand Rapids, won, 4 feet 10 inches; Platt, of Lansing, second; Bach, of Ann Arbor, third.

Running hop, step and jump—Christopher, of Lansing, won, 42 feet 1 inch; Stewart, Grand Rapids, second; Platt, Lansing, third.

Standing hop, step and jump—Christopher, of Lansing, won, 27 feet 7 inches; Stewart, of Grand Rapids, second; Sawyer, of Ann Arbor, third.

Running broad jump—Christopher, of Lansing, won, 18 feet 7 1/2 inches; Stewart, of Grand Rapids, second; Eddy, of Jackson, third.

220-yard dash—Christopher, of Lansing, won.

120-yard hurdle race—Christopher, of Lansing, won; time, 18 seconds; Stevens, of Ann Arbor, second; Eddy, of Jackson, third.

3-mile bicycle race—Bush, of Battle Creek, won; time, 12:23 3-5; Turner, of Battle Creek, second; Baxter, of Grand Rapids, third.

Ann Arbor won the baseball game this afternoon from Lansing by 13 to 12 and secured the silver cup. The diamond set gold all around medal was won by Christopher, of Lansing. The sapphire second all round medal was won by Eddy, of Jackson. About \$200 worth of gold medals were awarded.
