Sixth, 220-yard hurdle race—Winner, G. B. Wells, Ithaca; time, :30½. Seventh, mile bicycle race—Winner, Bradley Stone, Ithaca; time, 3:28¾. Eighth, lock-step run, 50 yards—Winners, G. B. Wells, E. Brown, L. Russell, Ithaca; time, 9 seconds. Ninth, half-mile race, teams of five—Winner, Ithaca team; time, 3:42½. Tenth, three-mile bicycle race—Winner, W. E. Barstow, Ithaca; time, 9:50. Eleventh, half-mile run—Winner, G. B. Wells, Ithaca; time, 2:31. Twelfth, running broad jump—Winner, F. E. Nevins, Alma; distance, 17 ft. 8 in. Thirteenth, running hop, step and jump—Winner, F. E. Cowdry, Ithaca; distance, 37 ft. 3 in.
