

The Detroit High School Won.

Lansing, Mich., June 6 .- (Special.) - The Detroit Lansing, Mich., June 6.—(Special.)—The Detroil High School came out a strong winner in the sports of the Michigan High School Athletic Association, which were concluded here to-day, having been postponed from Decoration day on account of rain. The points were as follows: Detroit, 72; Lansing, 52; Grand Rapids, 47; Ann Arbor, 77; Jackson, S. Christopher, of Lansing won the all-around medal, scoring 18 points against 17 for Hazen S. Pingree, Jr., of Detroit, who was in pretty much everything which came up to-day, and made some good records. Indeed, the high school boys rather outdid the athlete of the intercollegiate association at Albion, as the summaries will show:

Tompkins and Christopher, both of this city, who came in ahead in the 100-yard dash, were disqualified for putting Kittleman in a pocket, the latter being given the race. Lansing's protest was overruled. Ulp, of Ann Arbor, who won most of the bicycle races, lost the one-fourth mile race by removing his hands from the handle bars after reaching the wire. Summaries:
