Running high jump, 5 feet 2 inches; made by Prerdtis, of Detroit, in 1896.

Pole vault, 9 feet 1 inch; made by Christopher, of Lansing, in 1896.

Half-mile walk, 3:55 2-5; made by Eddy, of Jackson, in 1895.

Quarter-mile bicycle, :34; made by Phelps, of Grand Rapids, in 1896.
