

HIGH SCHOOL FIELD DAY.

Marshall starts the Meet Patriotic With
Albion a Close Second.

The second annual field day of the
Inter High School Athletic association
was held in this city Friday. Each
school got one banner as follows: Bat-
tle Creek, base ball; Albion, relay, and
Marshall, tug of war. Church of Al-
bion won the cup offered for the best
athletic school with 31 points. Jon
Denel of this city was second with 21.
In the score by schools Marshall is
ahead with 80 points, Albion getting
77 and Battle Creek 56, with the kick
if both feet to be decided between Mar-
dock and Church, the Albion man pro-
viding easiest the way in which "Doe"-
handed.

While the attendance in the morning
at the fair grounds and at the opera
house in the evening was not large, the
afternoon games were attended by 100
or 200 people and the event was a fi-
nancial success.

Sam Shipp of Albion college was the
referee and though many kicks were
registered his decisions were on the
whole fair. Following is the summary
of the day's events.

100 yard dash, Simpson, Battle Creek,
1st; Denel, 2d; Farley, Albion, 3d. Time,
17 seconds.

200 yard dash, Simpson, Battle Creek,
1st; Denel, 2d; Farley, Albion, 3d. Dis-
tance, 25 feet, 13 inches.

Base ball throw, Brandon, 1st; Mc-
Aniff, 2d and Reed, 3d; all of Albion.
Distance, 25 feet.

Quarter mile bicycle race, Van Ostrum,
Albion, 1st; Bush, Battle Creek, 2d;
Hewley, 3d. Time, 23 seconds.

120 yard hurdle, Merrill, 1st; Church,
Albion, 2d; Murdock, 3d. Time, 17 1/2
seconds.

In the tug of war Albion beat Battle
Creek and then Marshall's team, con-
sisting of Brewer, Davidson, Murdock
and Townsend beat Albion.

Half mile run, Hattenhorf, Battle
Creek, 1st; Simon, Albion, 2d; Hrensett,
3d. Time, 2:30.

Drop kick, Merrill, 1st; Sebastian, Al-
bion, 2d; Root, Battle Creek, 3d. Dis-
tance, 120 feet.

Running broad jump, Denel, 1st;
Merrill, 2d; Root, Battle Creek, 3d.
Distance 17 feet 6 1/2 inches.

Putting shot, Brewer, 1st; Davidson,
2d; Browning, Battle Creek, 3d. Dis-
tance 28 feet, 10 inches.

Albion won the mile relay race, Denel,
Murdock, Winsor and Merrill being
Marshall's team.

Half mile bicycle race, Van Ostrum,
Albion, 1st; Bush, Battle Creek, 2d;
Hewley, Battle Creek, 3d.

200 yard dash, Simpson, Battle Creek,
1st; Denel, 2d; Farley, Albion, 3d.
Time, 25 seconds.

Standing broad jump, Denel, 1st;
Root, Battle Creek, 2d; Farley, Albion,
3d. Distance, 9 feet, 11 inches.

Van Ostrum of Albion took the mile
bicycle race in 2:31 with Whites of Bat-
tle Creek 2d and Murdock, 3d.

Church of Albion took the quarter
mile run with Denel second.

Five yard, Winsor and Root, Battle
Creek tied for first place after a split
second contest, each making 8 feet, 4 in-
ches.

Relay tug of war, Simpson, Battle
Creek, 1st; Freese, Albion, 2d; Root, Battle
Creek, 3d. Distance, 25 feet, 10 inches.

Hattenhorf and Walters of Battle
Creek took first and second in the mile
run, with Nine of Albion, 3d. Time,
2:55.

Rotting high jump, Church, Albion,
1st; Root, Battle Creek, and Merrill
tied for second place. Distance 4 feet,
5 inches.

Hammer throw, Brewer, 1st; Barry,
Albion, 2d; Davidson, 3d. Distance, 51
feet, 7 inches.

Half mile walk, Church and Freese
of Albion 1st and 2d, Seymour, 3d.

In the evening McAniff and Simon of
Albion gave an exhibition in light
weight boxing and Hrensen threw feet
of Battle Creek in middle weight foot-
ing. The kick with both feet was given
to Church of Albion, with Murdock, 2d
and McAniff of Albion and Merrill
tied for 3d place. Church of Albion
took first in the bitc kick, with Mur-
dock second.
