

**HIGH SCHOOL FIELD DAY.**

**Some Fine Sport, Joe Deuel gets the Cathcart Cup This Year.**

The annual local field day of the Marshall high school occurred Saturday afternoon at the fair grounds. The attendance was not very large but those present witnessed some good sport as the boys were all anxious to win the Cathcart cup. The total gate receipts amounted to about \$12. Joe Deuel and Charles Merrill proved to be the two rivals in the cup race, but the former won it having 41 points to his credit against 21 for the latter. Roy Murdock made an excellent showing having won 16 points. The cup was presented by A. H. Cathcart in 1887 and in order to be held permanently must be won three years in succession. Ernest Verore held in 1897, Charles Merrill in 1898, and now Joe Deuel, who is a member of the freshman class, has it with good prospects of keeping it.

 One-half mile bicycle race—Murdock first, Bentley second, Townsend third.  
 One hundred twenty yards hurdles—Merrill first, Deuel second, Murdock third.  
 Four hundred forty yards dash—Deuel first, Winsor second.  
 One mile bicycle race—Bentley first, Murdock second, Grant third.  
 Running, hop, step, and jump—Deuel first, Murdock second, Merrill third.  
 One-half mile walk—Merrill first, Seymour second, McKee third.  
 Standing high jump—Dickey first, Winsor second.  
 Boys' one-half mile bicycle race—C. Page first, R. Weyler second, B. Miller third. Time 1:26.  
 Running broad jump—Deuel first, Murdock second, Hawkus third.  
 Girls' quarter mile bicycle race—Laural Fish first, Grigo Brooks second, Louise Chapman third. Time one minute.  
 Pole vault—Winsor first, Swinford second, Murdock third.  
 Relay race between high school classes was won by the freshmen, seniors second, sophomores third and juniors fourth.
