MARSHALL ATHLETES WON.

Had Things Their Own Way in K. B. A. A. Meet.

Marshall, Mich., May 31.—(Special.)—The second annual field day meet of the Kalamazoo River Athletic Association, comprising the high schools of this city, Battle Creek and Kalamazoo, occurred this afternoon at the Fair grounds. The attendance was good, there being about 400 present. The Marshall boys had everything their own way and scored 60 points against 19 for Kalamazoo and 17 for Battle Creek. Garry Deuel, of Marshall, won the all-around medal. He scored 30 points, while Bowen, of Kalamazoo, stood the next highest with 18 to his credit. S. C. Mason, of the Michigan university, was referee.
