

**KALAMAZOO COUNTY ATHLETES' FIELD DAY**

**HELD AT GALESBURG, WITH A BIG LIST OF ENTRIES.**

Galesburg, Mich., May 17.—(Special.)—The Kalamazoo County Athletic association, embracing all high schools in the county, save Kalamazoo city, held their annual meet in this village, at the Kirby grounds, to-day. The schools of Vicksburg, Climax, Augusta, Richland, Schoolcraft, Scotts, Alma and Galesburg were all fully represented. E. L. Brewer, physical director at Albion, was referee, and Supts. Platt, of Vicksburg, and Longman, of Richland, were judges. Results:

100-yard dash—Won by Terry of Schoolcraft; Reid, of Galesburg, second; Yorton, of Vicksburg, third.

Running high jump—Kirby, of Galesburg, won, with 5 ft. 2 in.; Jewett second; Harrigan third.

12-lb. shot put—Kirby won, 33.2 ft.; Clapp second; Knapp, of Schoolcraft, third.

100-yard run—Brouse, Vicksburg, won; Burroughs, Galesburg, second; Card, Climax, third.

Half-mile bicycle race—Davis, Schoolcraft, won; Adams, Galesburg, second; Motley, Vicksburg, third.

Burg, won, 3 ft. 10 in.; Kirby second; Smith, of Vicksburg, third.

Running high kick—Smith won, 8 ft.; Cummings second; Reid third.

100-yard hurdles—Yorton won; Foust second; Davis third.

Running broad jump—Burroughs, of Galesburg, won, 15 ft. 6 in.; Brown second; Platt, of Vicksburg, third.

Pole vault—Jewett, Richland, won; Cobb, Schoolcraft, second; Reid third.

12-lb. hammer throw—Terry won, 55 ft.; Kirby second; Knapp third.

Running high jump (boys under 16)—Payne won, 4 ft. 5 in.; Southworth second; Hamilton third.

Running broad jump—Cummings won, 17 ft. 2 in.; Foust second; Kirby third.

Pole vault, for boys under 16—Southworth, of Vicksburg, won, 7 feet; Payne, second; Griffith, third.

Two hundred and twenty yard run—Vinton, of Vicksburg, won; Marvin, second; Huler, third; both the latter of Climax.

Standing high jump—Reid, won; Terry, of Schoolcraft, second.

Running hop, step and jump—Kirby, of Galesburg, won, breaking the county record with 37 feet 6 inches; having already taken two firsts, he was obliged to be content with a lower place. Cummings, first; Harrigan, of Vicksburg, second.

One mile bicycle race—Davis, of Schoolcraft, first; Adams, Galesburg, second; Motley, Vicksburg, third.

Standing broad jump, for boys under 16—Voorhes, of Galesburg, won, 8 feet 2 inches; Burroughs, second, and Southworth, third.

One-fourth mile bicycle race, for boys—Strong, of Vicksburg, won; Paynes, second; Roof, of Climax, third.

The relay race was captured by Galesburg, only a Vicksburg team competing. The baseball game which a preliminary games had imposed upon Augusta and Vicksburg, was won by the latter, 20 to 8.
