D. U. S. BEATS OHIO SCHOOLS

LOCAL TRACK TEAM IS CHAMPION OF THE BUCKEYE STATE.

TOOK SIX FIRSTS OUT OF TEN EVENTS ON THE CARD.

OTHER SCHOOL MEETS THAT WERE HELD ON SATURDAY.

Cleveland, O., May 21.—(Special.)—The Detroit University school track team did themselves proud by winning the Ohio state track meet this afternoon. They led the field with a score of 37 points, while their nearest competitor, Cleveland South high school, had but 21. In the ten events that were contested D. U. S. won six firsts, three thirds and one fourth. By winning D. U. S. gets another handsome cup, the Ohio state championship trophy. This is the third meet D. U. S. has won in two weeks—the Detroit interscholastic, the Ann Arbor, and the Ohio state.

The schools that participated were Canton High, Elyria High, Willoughby High, South High and University School of Cleveland; Erie High school and the University School of Detroit. Summary:

200-yard hurdle—Meyer (Erie), won; Hatch (U. S.), second; Patterson (Detroit), third; Fordich (South High), fourth; time, 23 3-5 seconds.

Putting 15-pound shot—Davidson (Detroit), won; Hays (Willoughby), second; Saxe (Elyria), third; Robinson (U. S.), fourth; distance, 49 feet.

100-yard dash—Woodward (Detroit), won; Clark (U. S.), second; Fitting (Erie), third; Hubbell (S. H. S.), fourth; time, 11 1-5 seconds.

12-pound hammer—Wightman (South High), won; Webster (Willoughby), second; Pease (Detroit), third; Baehrens (Canton), fourth; distance, 118 feet 3 inches.

200-yard dash—Davidson (Detroit) won; Fitting (Erie) 2d; Clark (U. S.) 3d; Hubbell (S. H. S.) 4th. Time, 21 4-5 sec.

Running high jump—Patterson (Detroit) won; Wightman (S. H. S.) and Meyer (Erie) tied for 2d; Hatch (U. S.) 4th. Distance, 5 ft. 7 1-2 in.

40-yard run—Robinson (U. S.) won; Bernardi (Willoughby) second; Waldron (Detroit) third; Scarlett (Erie) fourth. Time 51 1-2 seconds.

Running broad jump—Wightman (South High), won; Meyer (Erie), second; Vixary (Canton), third; Keens (Detroit), fourth; distance, 17 feet 9 inches.

88-yard run—F. Keeler (Detroit), won; Quayle (U. S.), second; Mly (Elyria), third; Dunley (S. H. S.), fourth; time, 2:10.

Relay race won by Detroit. Team: Waldron, Davidson, Woodward and Keeler. Other entries: U. S. of Cleveland; Willoughby, Erie and South High.

First place counts five points, second three points, third two points, fourth one point. Detroit gets the cup, which, if won two out of three years, remains in its possession.
