## INTERSCHOLASTIC MEET

March 21 marked an innovation in indoor meets. Instead of having an inter-class meet as formerly, an interscholastic meet was arranged, open to all high schools in the state and neighboring states. This year only three teams were entered, those of Ann Arbor high, Detroit University, and Detroit Central high schools, but the meet was so successful as to warrant making it an annual event. With more competitors an annual indoor meet would bring about the same benefits Michigan now derives from the outdoor interscholastic meet; in fact an indoor meet would have a tendency to increase the interest in the annual outdoor event.

All the events were closely fought, though in the number of points the Detroit University school won handily with 481; Ann Arbor secured second place with 19, and Detroit Central scored 13%. The performances in the main were good, and reflect credit upon high school athletics.
