**D. U. S. AT NEW HAVEN.****TRACK TEAM REACHED YALE TOWN YESTERDAY.**

New Haven, Ct., May 15.—(Special.)—The D. U. S. track team arrived here in good condition, hopeful of winning a few places in the Yale interscholastic meet. This is the only team representing the west, Hyde Park and Lewis Institute not being here. One hundred and twenty-five athletes will compete from twenty schools, this being more than twice as many entries as last year. Davis, of Hill school, is picked to win the dash. Keeler is in fine shape and the event will be run in record time, which is 10-5 seconds. Doyle, of Worcester academy, is a favorite in the 40. F. Keeler will not compete by order of his doctor. Parson, of Lawrenceville, should win the half mile. Nichol, of D. U. S., has an excellent chance in the hurdles. Thomas, of Williston, is expected to take the weight events. Carhartt is feeling much better and will compete in the two mile. Colburn is stronger than when he met Chidsay last Saturday and can be depended upon to do a fast mile. D. U. S. should at least get a place in the high jump with Keene and Ford up to their standard. The team is stopping at the New Haven house, which is the general rendezvous of all the athletic teams that visit New Haven. The D. U. S. boys are being royally entertained by Allan Fox '03, ex-manager of the Yale football team; Charles Wright, '05, Richard Williams, '06, Ernest Baker, '04, Harry Stevens, '06, Haywood Murphy, '06 and other Detroit men who are now students at Yale.

This afternoon a carriage drive was enjoyed through New Haven's beautiful elm lined streets and rugged mountain park. Incidentally a chance was afforded to see several of the class and college crews of both Yale and Columbia at Lake Whitney, putting on the finishing touches for the annual spring regatta, which is held to-morrow afternoon on Lake Whitney. After the track meet, which begins at 2 o'clock to-morrow, there will be an opportunity to see Yale play Holy Cross at baseball. To-morrow evening the D. U. S. team will be given a dinner at the University club by Detroit's representatives at Yale.
