

DETROIT HAS GOOD CHANCE

D. U. E. ATHLETES MAKING GOOD SHOWING AT ANN ARBOR.

WILL PROBABLY FIGHT IT OUT WITH CHICAGO SCHOOLS.

FINALS IN 100-YARD DASH SHOULD BE HOT CONTEST.

Ann Arbor, Mich., May 22.—(Special.)—This afternoon the big interscholastic meet, with 29 high school athletes, was started, in order to weed out the chaff from the wheat. This morning in some of the big events were run off and it looks as if the championship will rest between Lewis institute, of Chicago, and the Detroit University school. Hyde Park did not send its team. Hopson, of Lewis institute, ran in 'varsity form, covering the 100 yards in 21.5, over a track that was heavy from rain. It will be a fine contest in the final between him and Keeler, of Detroit. Hopson is picked as a winner, owing to the fact that he has already beaten Keeler, of Hyde Park, this year. The Chicago man will also likely win the 200-yard dash.

Savage, of Lewis institute, seems strongest in the lowest hurdles, and Nicol, of the Detroit University school, is picked to win the high hurdles. In Lewis, of Charlevoix, there is a good quarter miler, but Shand, of Plainwell, and F. Keeler, of Detroit University school, will fight him hard. Ten men qualified for the half-mile run. Adams, of Lewis institute, and Eagle, of Ann Arbor, ran a dead heat in their trial and the final race will be an exciting one tomorrow. Tomorrow morning the field events will be pulled off and in the afternoon the final in all running races will be decided.
