Evart, Mich., June 5.—(Special.)—James R. Postal was presented with a racing wheel yesterday by his father and today won the one-half mile bicycle race in 1:18, winning by 150 yards, at the seventh annual northern Michigan high school interscholastic field day. This makes him winner of the silver medal for each of the past four years. He also won the pole vault at nine feet six inches, which breaks all field day records.
