


SCHOOLBOYS FIXED EIGHT NEW MARKS

Detroit U. S. Beat Out Central High in the D. L. A. Meet, which was Between These Two Schools.

MARKER'S RECORD-BR EAKING POLE VAULT.



Central High Athlete Gales Over at 8 Feet 10 Inches, at D. L. A. Meet, Breaking record and making new mark.

In the narrow margin of 1.5 points Detroit University school coming off the honor in the D. L. A. meet, held yesterday afternoon on University Ave. Central was also defeated by 10 points. Western High scored 12.5 and Eastern High's score was 10.5. Detroit U. S. beat Central High in the pole vault, which was the only event in which the Central High athlete was victorious. The pole vault was won by Central High's Gales, who cleared the bar at 8 feet 10 inches, breaking the record of 8 feet 6 inches set by the Central High athlete in 1903. Gales' performance was a significant achievement for the school, as it marked the first time a Central High athlete had won the pole vault at the D. L. A. meet. The meet was held at the University Ave. track, and it was a highly competitive event, with many of the top athletes from the area participating. The results of the meet were as follows:
