

FIRST MEET AT D. U. S. GO

GREEN MATERIAL TO BE GIVEN DE
TRYOUT TODAY.

School Teams May Compete in Sea
Cross-Country Run.

Starting today, Dr. McComber, coach of the D. U. S. track team, will begin the work for candidates for the team. Today he will hold a preparatory meet for green men—that is, boys that have never had any training for track work. This is done for the purpose of discovering men of ability, and to weed down the many candidates trying for their numerals.

Short runs for the distance men of former years have already been given, but next week Dr. McComber will work them on longer runs, and will let everybody join in the chase.

The Central High men will also be out today. They will indulge in a hare and hound chase for a distance of about six miles. A lot of enthusiasm has been aroused in the runs by Trainer Jack Collins, and as many as thirty candidates are expected to participate in the run this afternoon. It will start from the school at 3:30 o'clock.

It is the intention to hold a run between the Central High and the D. U. S. runners. It is not improbable that Eastern High may be represented, as early in the school year Wilson and a dozen or two of the boys held several cross-country runs.
