

Fast Work at Rapids.

Grand Rapids, Mich., May 13.—(Special.) —The Grand Rapids High school held its annual field day, and in the fifty yard dash, won by Legrande Alber, the time caught by the three official timekeepers, and by several of their stop watches was 5 2-5 seconds, which equals Arthur Duffy's world record. Joseph Horner hurled the twelve-pound shot 43 feet 1 inch, falling only 1 inch behind the interscholastic record of Michigan, as held by Evvard, of Pontiac, Ill.
