

Calumet Won Meet.

At the upper peninsula high school track meet held at Ishpeming on Tuesday of this week, Calumet won first place, Ishpeming second and Bessemer third. The number of points scored by each of the competing teams was as follows:

Calumet 41½; Ishpeming, 32½; Bessemer, 26; Norway 14; Escanaba, 7; Hancock, 6; Ironwood 6. Munising and Menominee did not score.

It will be seen by the above score that the Bessemer team made an excellent showing, having won as many points as Norway, Hancock and Ironwood combined, over twice as many as Norway, and only 6½ less than Ishpeming, the winner of the cup last year. This is Bessemer's first year as a winner of points in the track meet and the boys have every reason to feel satisfied with the showing made. Those of the Bessemer team who won in this contest were as follows:

Roy Zeh, third in the 100 yard dash. In this race had the rules of the association been followed, Bessemer would have received first place, Ishpeming and Calumet men called back for leaving the mark ahead of the signal should have been disqualified. Will Kulaszewicz, first in pole vault, best jump, 8 feet and 3 inches; Roy Zeh, second in discus throw; F. Byrne, third in high jump; John Kallander, first in hammer throw, 101 feet, 3 inches.
