

RAIN SPOILED MEET

ONLY FIVE EVENTS RUN OFF AT BOIS BLANC.

CENTRAL HIGH HAS EASY LEAD UP TO PRESENT.

Games Will Be Completed in Town on Saturday.

Rain prevented all but a few events of the D. A. C. meet yesterday at Bois Blanc, also keeping away many intended spectators, although about 1,000 made the trip on the morning boat. But five events, in all, were run off, these being the interscholastic 400-yard dash, 800-yard run and mile run, and the mile event in the D. A. C. and open contests. The baseball game between Eastern and Western was also postponed and will, in all probability, be played Wednesday at the D. A. C. The remainder of the meet will be run at the D. A. C. field next Saturday afternoon at 1:30 o'clock.

In the three scholastic events that did take place, Central High made a grand clean up, winning twenty-one points out of the possible twenty-seven.

Indian Did Not Appear.

Hanavan, Central's crack miler, won both the scholastic and open mile events. The Indian, Pierce, did not make an appearance for the open meet, and Hanavan won easily in fast time, considering the poor condition of the track. As expected, Chidsey, the old Central high star, won the D. A. C. mile, by a half a lap over the only other two contestants, who finished on the dog-trot.

Scotty Smith, the only Eastern high lad to put in an appearance, won his event, the half-mile, by ten yards, in a grand sprint at the finish. The 400 was easy for Farnsworth, Central winning all the points in this event. Ann Arbor high took but one point.

Considerable discussion arose as to whether or not the athletes who were entered in the meet, but not present to contest, should be allowed to contest next Saturday at the D. A. C., but the judges and officials ruled that they would not. This affects the D. U. S. the most. The summary:
