

NEW ENTRIES AT D. A. C.

OPEN EVENTS SATURDAY GIVEN ADDED INTEREST.

Additional entries that promise to make things interesting in the D. A. C. open events in Saturday's meet have been received by Jake Mazer, and the three events other than the special mile run—the 100-yard dash, high jump and shot-put—will furnish some very lively competition.

Malcomson and Vaughn, of the D. U. S., has worked hard all season, having won entered in the 100, and Arthur, of the D. U. S., and Durfee, of Wayne, promise to make it interesting in the shot-put. Patterson has also entered in the open high jump, and Chidsey and De Berg, both of this city, are entered in the special mile open event. At first it was thought that Hanavan would enter in this event, but he and Widman, of the Central High, are first in the Detroit and Michigan Inter-scholastic meets, also first in the 'scholastic and open mile runs in the D. A. C. meet at Bois Blanc last Saturday, and took second place in the Michigan cross-country run against many of the crack runners of the University team. This has kept him in training several weeks longer than is usual and he has broken training for this season.

The open event entries which were received will close Friday evening, the day before the meet at the D. A. C.
