

D. A. C. WILL GIVE MEET

ATHLETICS ALL OVER STATE INVITED TO PARTICIPATE.

Open Contests Provided for the Best Men in the Country.

At a meeting of the officers and board of directors of the D. A. C., held last evening at the club, plans were made for the D. A. C. second annual interscholastic field meet, open to all interscholastic track teams in Michigan. The date of the meet was set for Saturday, June 9, and will be held at Bois Blanc island. Eugene A. Bresler was elected chairman of the athletic arrangement committee for the field day and work will be started immediately to complete all the plans for the day. Last year nearly all the events had to be postponed, rain spoiling the day set at Bois Blanc, and it was completed the Saturday afterwards at the D. A. C. grounds. This year better weather is hoped for and efforts will be put forth to make it the best meet of its kind ever held in the state. Besides the regular interscholastic events there will be four open events, open to any amateur in the United States, with gold, silver and bronze medals in all events, both open and scholastic.

In all there will be eighteen events, fourteen scholastic and four open. The complete list decided upon follows: Interscholastic—100 yard dash, 220 yard dash, 440 run, 880 yard run, one mile run, 120 low hurdles, 120 high hurdles, high jump, running broad jump, pole vault, 12-pound hammer throw, 12-pound shot put and discus throw. Open—100 yard dash, mile run, 12-pound shot put and high jump.
