

COOK OF CHILLICOTHE PROVES STAR OF MICHIGAN PREP MEET

Does 23 Feet 5 Inches in Broad Jump, 6 Feet in High Jump, 11 Feet in Pole Vault, and Runs 100 Yards in 0:10 Flat.

ANN ARBOR, Mich., May 25.—The first day of the University of Michigan annual interscholastic meet resulted in the smashing of smithereens of the preparatory school record in the broad jump. Cook, the "one man team" from Chillicothe, Ohio, doing 23 feet 5 inches. This is a remarkable performance for a preparatory school lad, and can be equaled by but few university or college athletes in the country.

In the high jump also there was something doing. Patterson, the tall, red haired lad from Detroit University school, cleared 6 feet 1 1/4 inches, Cook clearing 5 feet 3/4 inch. This establishes a new record, Cook having previously set the mark at 5 feet 9 inches.

In the pole vault Cook tied the old interscholastic mark of 11 feet, made by Wilkins last year. He won the event at this mark, the best any of his competitors could do being 10 feet 9 inches.

Cook Scores Thirteen Points.
Cook thus captured 13 points for Chillicothe, and put his school at the head of the bunch. Lewis institute of Chicago comes next with 10 1/2 points, and Detroit University school is third with 5. The other schools which have scored are Grand Rapids, 3; Ann Arbor, 1 1/2.

Cook is counted upon to win the 100 yard dash tomorrow, as he captured his trial heat today in 0:10 flat. The Chillicothe relay team also has a good chance of winning first place.

Detroit University school will show up strong tomorrow, as will Lewis institute, and it is probable that the championship will be fought out between these two schools, with Chillicothe third.
