

**MEET WILL LACK D. U. S.****BOIS BLANC DATE CLASH WITH STAGG'S GAMES.**

Because of the conflict in dates with Coach Alonzo Stagg's annual prep school track meet at Chicago, the annual D. A. C.-interscholastic field and track meet, to be given Saturday, June 2, under the auspices of the D. A. C., will be minus the great performers of Detroit University school. This school, which unquestionably has one of the best balanced teams in the country, has been working for the past year with the idea of sweeping things at Chicago, and consequently the best material of the school will be in the Windy City, when other local and state schools are fighting it out at Bois Blanc. No doubt a number of D. U. S. athletes will make the trip down river, but none of the picked men. D. A. C. is powerless to avoid complications, as June 2 is the Saturday the park is available.

The meet this year will be confined strictly to schools of the state and to D. A. C. members. At a meeting yesterday of the managers of local school teams and the D. A. C. executive, it was decided to restrict entries to schools of Michigan, the interscholastic competition to be governed by Michigan Interscholastic Athletic association rules. By general consent the preparatory departments of Detroit college were also admitted. In this case contestants will have to be of less than 21 years of age, and in good standing in school work.

It has been decided to dispense with the usual open events for amateurs. The open interscholastic events will include: 100 yards dash, 220 yards dash, 440 yards dash, half-mile run, mile run, 120 yards low hurdles, 120 yards high hurdles, one mile relay, high jump, broad jump, pole vault, twelve-pound hammer throw, twelve-pound shot put and discus. Handicap events for club members will be: 100 yard dash, half-mile run, broad jump, 120 yards low hurdles, and twelve-pound shot put.

Entries will close Saturday, June 2, one week before the meet. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded the individual winners, as well as suitable trophies for team winners.
