

EASY FOR CADETS

M. M. A. TRACK BOYS DID THINGS
TO E. H. S. TEAM.

NEVER HAD A LOOK IN, WINNING
BUT TWO FIRSTS.

Cadets Look to Have Fair Team—
Final Score Was 79 to 22.

Orchard Lake, Mich., May 4.—(Special).—In rather an easy manner the M. M. A. track team defeated the Detroit Eastern High school track boys here this afternoon by a score of 79 to 22, the Indians landing but two first places, Suckert getting them both, one being in the 220-yard dash and the other in the 120-yard low hurdles. M. M. A. won all the other places, with the exception of four seconds. Suckert also won two of these. For the Cadets, Strellinger and Balhatchet did the best work, the first named winning three firsts, taking them in the weights, while Balhatchet landed two firsts and figured in the relay team's victory.

While no sensational work was done, the work of M. M. A. shows that they have a fair all-around team. The Indians are not disheartened, as they expected defeat, but will now put forth a stronger effort to bring around a better team. Two men from each school were allowed to enter in each event, and but the first two positions counted, first getting five points and second three.
