

**CENTRAL A WINNER**

**MORE THAN DOUBLED POINTS OF ANN ARBOR.**

**LATTER GOT FIRST IN THREE OF THE EVENTS.**

**Widman Did Great Work for Central in Dash.**

For the first time this season, Central High school followers had a chance, yesterday afternoon, at the D. A. C. grounds, to see the track team of that institution under fire. The occasion was a dual track meet with Ann Arbor high, which the locals won handsily by the fine score of 78 1/2 points to 36 1/2. Though in no case were interscholastic records shattered, the work on the whole was passing fair for this early season, and holds out promise of better things than usual this year, for Central's slender high squad.

As would readily be seen from the final result, the Detroiters had things much their own way in the majority of events. Of the thirteen events Central took nine trials and tied for another, the pole vault, six second places and one third place. In the half mile run, as well as the broad jump Ann Arbor squeezed out five places.

**Widman Won Two Events.**

Widman did great work in the dash for Central, taking the 200 yards and 220 yards dashes in clever style. Garret, a student brother of Widman, of the C. C. M., made a bold proposition in the short race, beating out Benjamin of Ann Arbor in a magnificent sport by a start in 46 1/2 seconds. Next, for the 100 yards, had rather a narrow race, for the victor, and Brodie, was never in any danger in the mile race, which had 1 1/2 seconds. In the broad jump, taking the event with 29 ft. 5 in. Central had everything in the bag, but lost a point when Central's the victor, took by going outside for third. The weight events were rather disconcerting.

Perhaps one of the best events of the day was the relay race, which fell to the Detroiters. Hawkins and Hill hit up a merry race, and the start the latter making a little the better of the argument. La Cing more than made up the loss earlier, but Stewart, but Cornell set down the lead on Brown. This left it up to Widman, and he made a magnificent finish over the latter, finishing second up.
