

HAVE 110 ENTERED

THAT NUMBER OF MEN FOR THE D. A. C. MEET.

FULL TEAMS ARE NAMED BY SIX OF THE SCHOOLS.

Central Will Not Send Anyone in to Stagg's Meet.

Last evening the entry list for the D. A. C. annual interscholastic and club meet, at Bois Blanc, next Saturday, closed, six schools—Central, Western and Eastern Highs, D. U. S., Detroit college and Ann Arbor—entering full teams, with a few from two or three more state high schools. While the D. U. S. has entered a full team, but few men will compete, all the stars of the team going to Chicago on that day to participate in Stagg's interscholastic meet. The club events are well filled also. In all, there are ten men entered.

Last week the matter of sending four of the Central High stars—Widman, Brown, Craig and Hanavan—was discussed by the athletic board, but was left undecided. Yesterday it was stated that it was improbable that they will attend, the boys themselves not taking to the idea readily, not feeling sure of the points expected of them. Then they figure that with the best of the D. U. S. team in Chicago, the matter of winning the D. A. C. meet would be a moral cinch. With the four cracks absent the victory would be no easy one, with four or five schools working against them, and figuring it this way, the boys themselves are satisfied to stay at home and win glory.

All is well at the D. U. S. training again, Patterson, the school's swell high jumper and hurdler, returning to work, with the swelling in his knee practically gone. He worked in the low hurdles as well as the high, yesterday, it being the intention of Coach Ryan to use his boys in all the events possible. Last year Lewis Institute won the meet with but twelve points, and D. U. S. was the very closest of seconds, with eleven and one-half points. D. U. S. figures to win the meet this year with three first to start on; namely, the high jump, low and high hurdles and a fine chance in the relay race. Then Arthur is figured on for five of six points in the weight events as well as places in the dashes, which the school followers figure ought to be ample to land first this year.

Just who will be taken to Chicago is as yet undecided, but among those who will go with Coach Ryan are Capt. Arthur, Malcomson, Patterson, White, Sparling, Torey, Woodcock and Trainer Walker.
