

CROSS COUNTRY RUN

Divisions of High School Athletes Will Compete on Saturday.

Under the direction of Assistant Athletic Instructor Field of the Y. M. C. A. the first cross country run of the 1907 season will take place Saturday morning. Two divisions of the high school class will compete in a five to eight mile cross country race in a generally eastern course out of the city. Some score of the boys eligible to this class of Y. M. C. A. athletics are training for cross country work and some fifteen will start in Saturday's event.

Director Morgan is arranging for a strenuous, interesting cross country season. There will doubtless be a senior race of this character Thanksgiving day. At that time the intermediate class of the association will compete with the high school class in such an event and the old five mile road race on the South Division street course will doubtless take place. It is promised that this is to be the busiest Thanksgiving in the history of our outdoor athletics under the management of the Y. M. C. A.

The basketball season has now opened and several teams are hard at training. Grand Rapids should this year have a state champion team and the indications are that the best of the local basketball outfits will take a tour of one week through the state in search of state championship honors. This trip will be taken during the last week of February.
