SEVEN SCHOOLS COMPETE IN FALL FIELD DAY.

St. John's Episcopal Team Is First in Senior Events, North Congregational in Intermediate, and Boulevard Congregational in Junior.

Despite the handicap of cold weather the Sunday School Athletic League had a very successful field day at the D. A. C. grounds yesterday morning. The number of competitors was large, seven Sunday schools being represented and the various events were closely contested.

Among the most interesting races of the program were the relays, of which there were three, one for each of the departments represented in the meet. The potato race, in which the juniors competed, furnished abundant amusement for contestants and spectators alike.

St. John's Episcopal Sunday school carried off the honors in the senior department, winning 31 points. The Boulevard Congregational was second, with 29 points. While the First Baptist had 2, in the intermediate, the North Congregational scored 21 points against 13 for the Boulevard Congregational. The last named Sunday school took first place in the junior events, with a total of 14 points. The North Woodward Methodists took 8.
