

## ANN ARBOR COPS MEET

### University City School Athletes Carry Off Chief Honors at M. A. C.

#### ONE OF BEST EVER SEEN IN THE STATE

Agricultural College, Mich., May 18.—The second annual Central and Southern Michigan interscholastic track and field meet, given under the auspices of the local athletic association today, was a decided success in every way. Without a doubt it was the best meet of its kind ever held in Michigan. Twenty-one different high schools sent in entries and twenty had athletes on hand for the events.

Ann Arbor had by far the strongest team of any of the schools and carried off the grand pennant easily, having forty-one points out of a possible 105. Of their team Richards won two firsts, Ben Ollivier one first and one second. The team was especially strong in the runs and every man won at least two points.

Clifford, the one-man team of Olivet, won two firsts and tied Richards of Ann Arbor for the highest number of points of a single athlete. Of the other schools Belding, Freepoint and Saginaw each made nine points, Memphis secured 8, Jackson and Bay City each 6, St. Johns, Mason and Charlotte each 3, Battle Creek 4, while Lansing, which ran away with the meet last year, succeeded in landing only one point.
