**IN EVIDENCE**

**Great Work of Grand Rapids Man Cinches Athletic Meet at Muskegon.**

**ATHLETE SCORES 36 OF TEAM'S 59 POINTS**

Muskegon, Mich., June 1.—The stellar all around work of Capt. Joe Horner, the Grand Rapids weight man, pole vaulter and hurdler, won the first annual Western Michigan invitation meet that dedicated the new Hockley Athletic field this afternoon. Grand Rapids scored fifty-nine points, Muskegon forty-nine and Shelby high school twenty-seven points. Horner won a total of thirty-six points.

Dick, the star Muskegon pointer, and Hammond, another of Muskegon's strong entries, were out of the meet, and only second string men competed for Muskegon. Itun, an unknown athlete from Shelby, scored twenty-two points for his team, cutting in heavily on Muskegon's points.

Gold, silver and bronze medals to point winners, and banners to the winning school and relay team were awarded. Summary:

Broad jump—Runner, Shelby, first; Page, Grand Rapids, second; Zeepp, Muskegon, third. Distance 20 feet 7 inches.

Discus throw—Horner, Grand Rapids, first; Runner, Shelby, second; Frost, Muskegon, third. Distance 108 feet 10 inches.

Hammer throw—Horner, Grand Rapids, first; Zeepp, Muskegon, second; Frost, Muskegon, third. Distance 118 feet 2 inches.

Shot-put—Horner, first; Runner, Shelby, second; Frost, third. Distance 48 feet 4 inches.

High jump—Horner, first; Runner, second; Zeepp, third. High, 5 feet 6 inches.

Relay race, half mile—Won by Grand Rapids; Muskegon and Shelby tied for second. Winning team: Horner, Goetz, Darline Sullivan. Time 1:16.
