

BUSY SEASON FOR THE LOCAL TRACK TEAMS

Central High and D. U. S. Squads Have Hard Schedules for This Year.

The fine weather of last week was just what the local prep school track trainers and athletes were longing for, and both the D. U. S. and Central High squads enjoyed four or five of the best outside works they have had since the spring training opened. Both squads get their first action on May 3, which means they have but two weeks left to get in shape.

Just which meets the two will go in for on that date is still a question in both camps. However, it is quite probable that D. U. S. will go to M. A. C. for a dual meet with Brewer's varsity squad, while Central High will hook up in a triangular meet with Ann Arbor High and Michigan Military academy at the D. U. S. There are still a few points to be cleared up before the triangular meet will be a certainty, while if Coach Kickerbocker can induce Coach Brewer to release the D. U. S. from a signed contract on May 3 the D. U. S. will have representatives at the Council interscholastic meet at Ithaca on that date. In return for the release the D. U. S. would send a team to Brewer's interscholastic meet at Lansing on May 16, to which Central High will also send a team.

Changes in D. U. S. Dates.

D. U. S. at first had the Cleveland University school track team booked for May 16, but the Cleveland team has refused the date, on account of the squabble last year over the relay race at Cleveland and will not come, although Coach Kickerbocker has offered them every inducement within reason. With Cleveland refusing, D. U. S. will, of course, go to Lansing for Brewer's annual meet. This will be one of the two times Central and D. U. S. clash this season, although at out Central refusing to schedule dates with the University school in any branch of sport.

Their next clash will be at the annual Michigan interscholastic meet at Ann Arbor, May 22 and 23, just one week later. Both Central and D. U. S. will go after this affair strongly.

After this meet each has one more date booked, D. U. S. going to Evanston, Ill. for the annual school meet under the direction of the Northwestern university, while a week later Central High goes to Chicago to the meet given by Coach Stagg, of the Chicago university, on Marshall field June 6.

There is a chance that the rivals will get together locally, but this is a slim one. There is some talk of the Y. M. C. A. holding an outdoor invitation high school meet at the D. U. S. some time in the early part of June. This is not settled as yet, neither is it certain that they would both enter, although Central High has expressed a willingness to compete should the "Y" decide to hold one.
