

**RECORD ENTRY
IN M. A. C. MEET**

**Over 250 Athletes Entered in
Brewer's Affair on
Saturday.**

**THIRTY TOWNS OF THE
STATE REPRESENTED**

**Detroit Central Has Twenty-two
Entrants and Good Chance
to Land First.**

East Lansing, Mich., May 13.—Over 250 high school athletes, representing thirty cities in all parts of the state, will compete for honors in the annual Central Michigan interscholastic track and field meet to be held here on Saturday afternoon under the auspices of the M. A. C. athletic association. Practically every high school of importance in the lower peninsula is entered in the thirteen events. Coach C. L. Brewer will referee the events.

Ann Arbor and Lansing, who have won first place in previous meets, have entered many strong men and will work hard to land the banner again. Traverse City will come the farthest distance with six men. Detroit Central High has entered the largest team, and with twenty-two men has a good show for first honors.

A total of 88 men have entered in the 100-yard dash and 51 men in the 110-yard run. The honors by task of starting and judging will fall to the M. A. C. athletes.

The young athletes will have a good opportunity to witness track and field events of high class in the forenoon when the annual dual meet between Notre Dame and M. A. C. will be pulled off. Notre Dame is champion of its state and a hard contest is expected.
