

**PORT HURON WON
THE TRACK MEET**

**Sarnia, Only Opponent, Secured But
15 Points.**

**Nearly Every Event Went to Local
School.**

**Two Fast Games of Baseball—The De-
tails.**

From every standpoint the high school students and friends enjoyed themselves at Tashmoo park on Saturday, the occasion being the annual outing of the Marine City, Detroit Western, St. Clair, Sarnia and Port Huron high schools. A large crowd from each city named was present.

The athletic events were the chief attraction and with two baseball games and several track contests, the picnickers were well furnished with amusement in this line. Port Huron won the track meet, securing 47 points to Sarnia's 15. The events were not participated in as generously as was anticipated, and only Port Huron and the Canadian city appeared in the list of entries. St. Clair did not have a man to enter. The result:

100 Yard Dash—Heffron, Sarnia; Fead, Port Huron; Hill, Port Huron. Time—10 4-5.

One-Third Mile Run—Hill, Port Huron; Weston, Port Huron; Proctor, Sarnia. Time—1:15.

Standing Broad Jump—Fead, Port Huron; Heffron, Sarnia; Lamlein, Port Huron. Distance—9 feet 6 inches.

Running Broad Jump—Fead, Port Huron; Heffron, Sarnia; Lamlein, Port Huron. Distance—17 feet 4 inches.

High Jump—Fead, Port Huron; Heffron, Sarnia. Distance—4 feet 7 inches.

In the pole vault and the mile run there were no entries but Port Huron, and Coach Eddie French, of Detroit Western High, who acted as judge, awarded the points to Port Huron in each of the two events.
