

JOHN SPIEGEL WINS TRINITY CUP TITLE

Local Boy Takes Twenty-three Points—Mills and Tilley His Only Rivals.

By taking 23 points, John Spiegel won the all-around out-door championship of the Detroit University school and also wins the right to have his name engraved on the Trinity cup, this being the annual contest for that glory. His rivals were Mills and Tilley, and had the latter finished his competition he doubtless would have won the title, but he tired and did not compete in the broad jump, an event in which he had a certain first, but which J. Spiegel and Newton divided first and second honors in.

As it was Tilley took second and Mills third, with 20 and 18 points respectively. This victory gives Spiegel first honors in both the out-door and in-door competitions of the school this year. Hawkins nor Hannevan did not compete, interest lagging in the contest this year. The summaries:

50 yards dash—J. Spiegel, first; Mills, second; W. Spiegel, third. Time, 16 1/2 seconds.

120 low hurdles—J. Spiegel, first; Tilley, second; Mills, third. Time, 14 seconds.

Quarter mile run—Mills, first; Tilley, second; no third. Time, 58 1/2 seconds.

Half mile run—Seymour, first; D. Flowerree, second; no third. Time, 3 minutes 5 1/2 seconds.

Broad jump—J. Spiegel and W. Newton tied for first; Tilley, third. Distance, 19 feet 2 inches.

High jump—Mills and J. Spiegel tied for first; Newton, third. Height, 5 feet.

Shot put—J. Spiegel, first; Tilley, second; Mills, third. Distance, 29 feet 10 1/2 inches.

Discus throw—Tilley, first; Mills, second; Newton, third. Distance, 95 feet 6 inches.

Hammer throw—Tilley, first; no second or third. Distance, 157 feet.
