

### TOLEDO IS BASY FOR D. U. S. TEAM

**Maumee City Athletes Are Beaten  
in Dual Meet by Score  
of 56 to 25.**

**THE VISITORS' SPRINTING  
STAR IS DISAPPOINTMENT**

**Middle Distance Events Are Cap-  
tured by the Lads From  
Buckeye State.**

Toledo high school track team, figured on to give Detroit University school team a tough argument, was like putty in the hands of the speedy easters, yesterday. Toledo came to town fully expecting to do as well against the blue and red as it had done with Ann Arbor earlier in the season. To say that they didn't would be putting it mildly. Instead, the Elmwood lads simply played horse with the Maumee aggregation. When the ten events had been completed, all of which counted for points with the exception of the relay race, D. U. S. had run up a total of 56 to the visitors' 25.

Couch Knickerbocker's boys took six heats, seven seconds and finished third in two events, the high jump and quarter mile. These two with the basketball were the places that the Toledo lads were the place they were superior to the local lads, and when Knickerbocker or Woodman, both of whom are on the district list, were able to run in the quarter mile, there is a chance that D. U. S. would have made a better showing here.

Monetta, Toledo's supposedly star in the sprints, failed to show his expected form in any of the events that he entered. Both the 100 yard and 200 yard races were won by local lads handily. In the 100 yard race, and in the 200 yard race, W. W. Spiegel took the place of the 27th. When Spiegel and Tuomy administered the same dose.

In both the quarter-mile and half-mile the visitors, showed superiority of a superior, by meeting superior in the former and superior in the latter event, in remarkably fast time for an indoor track. In the half-mile race, which the Toledo lads won, the Toledo lads were 26 1/2 seconds behind, and in the quarter-mile race, of D. U.
