

**PORT HURON TEAM
WON TRACK MEET**

**Defeated Detroit Western High Here
Friday Afternoon.**

**Locals Were Ahead From Start to
Finish.**

By a score of 53 to 37 the Port Huron high school track team won its third successive meet this season at the Athletic field Friday afternoon from the team of the Detroit Western high school. From start to finish the locals were ahead in points and never at any time was the score tied or with the larger numerals in to the credit of the visitors.

The meet was the fastest in which the home team has participated this season and is the last one on the 1909 schedule. It was also the last track meet to be conducted by Coach Small, of the track team, as next season Small will be handling the team of the Louisville, Ky., high school.

Pole vault—Saunders, Port Huron, 1st; Spers, of Detroit, and Jenks, of Port Huron, tied for second. Height vaulted, nine feet.

Running broad jump—Saunders, Port Huron, 1st; Mann, Detroit, 2nd; Glenn Clark, Port Huron, 3rd. Distance jumped, 18 feet 1 1-2 inches.

Running high jump—Her, Detroit, 1st; Mann, Detroit, 2nd; Clark, Port Huron, 3rd. Height jumped, 18 1-2 inches.

110 yard hurdles—Weston, Port Huron, 1st; Spers, Detroit, 2nd; Irwin, Detroit, 3rd. Time 15 seconds.

Relay race—Clark, Seaver, Weston and Clark for Port Huron; Spers, Gauthier, Mann and Posco for Detroit. Port Huron 1st.
