BULK OF POINTS GO TO SENIORS

Twelfth Grade is Easy Winner in Central High School's Annual Meet.

With the Twelfth grade more than doubling the score of any other team, the annual Central high inter-grade was pulled off last night in the school gym. The lower grades were bucking such "C" men as Bruce and Chambers, both of whom proved individual stars. These two scored nearly half of the winners' points, Bruce getting away with 11, while his teammate beat him out with 13. The Twelfth carried off the majority of points in each event, with the exception of the half-mile, which was won by Monroe of the Ninth, second and third going to the Ninth and Tenth, respectively. The sensation of the evening was Wilson, a freshman, who showed fine form in both the high jump and the pole vault. While Chambers beat him in the first, he counted five for the Ninth in the pole event. This boy certainly should gather in a few points for Collins's squad in the big meets.

In the mile, in which all eight starters finished, Smith of the Tenth proved a winner after a slow start, finishing up in fine shape. This proved the best race of the performance, with the exception of the 220-yard dash, in which Bradley of the Eleventh tied Jacobi, thus scoring the Juniors' only point.
