

WILL HOLD ATHLETIC MEET HERE FOR THE HIGH SCHOOLS

Arrangements are being made to hold an interscholastic indoor athletic meet some time next month in the Y. M. C. A. gym for high school athletes of the copper country. Physical Director Sherwood is engaged in making the plans for the meet and hopes to be in a position to announce them shortly.

Invitations will be extended to Houghton, Hancock, Dollar Bay, Lake Linden, and Calumet high schools to take part. Suitable trophies will be offered for competition, and it is likely that the meet, if arranged, will be largely attended.

Among the events to be pulled off will be an 18-yard dash, a potato race, a relay race, pole vault, high and broad jump, etc. Each school will be entitled to a certain number of entries for the relay race and the rest of the events likely will be thrown open to as many representatives as care to take part.

Director Sherwood, too, proposes to pull off an outdoor interscholastic event in the Y. M. C. A. athletic park the coming summer. Arrangements were practically completed today to play the second of the series of the high school Y. M. C. A. basket ball games on Saturday evening this week. The first game of the series resulted in a victory for the Y. M. C. A. team by the close margin of 2 points. This should make the second game of the series a most interesting one.

The seventh of the series of basket ball games in the Y. M. C. A. Commercial basket ball league will be played Wednesday evening. The teams to be engaged are the Bee Hive and Uiseth Lumber Co., the Vertin and Keekonen teams, and Petermann Bros. and Warren Jewelry Co.
