

## PORT HURON WINS FLINT TRACK MEET

SCORE WOULD HAVE EVEN BEEN  
GREATER IF PROTEST WOULD  
HAVE HELD GOOD

Friday morning the Port Huron high school track team boarded the train for Flint, with the intent purpose of trampling on the high school track team of that place, and today the Port Huron boys are telling how they handed it to Flint by a score of 88 to 48. On the team of the Flint high appeared the name of Wildanger who was down in his studies, but who had the reputation of being a star on his track. Of course he was protested by the Port Huron boys, but, under some pretence or other, he was allowed to enter. Port Huron beat them anyway, and if he had not been allowed to play the total score would have been 78 to 38.

Clay Jenks, of Port Huron, was the shining light throughout the whole of the afternoon's events, securing 26 1/4 of the points for Port Huron. He took the first in the high hurdles, 220 yards low hurdles, 220 yards dash, 100 yards dash, was tied for first place in the pole vault, and took a prominent part in the relay. In the 440 yards dash, Gundry, of Flint, crossed the line at the end of 34 2/5 seconds, pushed close by Springer, of Port Huron. This time lacked 2/5 of tying the interscholastic record made at Ann Arbor. Following is the summary of the game.
