**HANCOCK WINS THE HIGH SCHOOL MEET WITH 60 POINTS**

**Calumet, Second and Houghton Third in Interscholastic Meet at Driving Park**

**ONLY FOUR SCHOOLS ENTERED**

Out of a total of 111 points made in the interscholastic track meet at the driving park, on Saturday last, the Hancock high school team being given three first place and the district championship, Calumet was second with 28, Houghton third with 9 and Palmsdale fourth with six. McElroy and Smith were the star athletes of the victorious team, the former breaking a couple of records by reducing the time for the mile run, doing it in 4:17, and doing the two-mile run in 10:42 1/2—a gain of 2 1/2 seconds.

Notwithstanding the cold wind at the driving park, and the fact that it started to rain while the games were in progress, the athletes continued their work and the large crowd of spectators remained until the finish. The meet was a success in every way, free from wrangling and was pulled off in a most sportsmanlike manner. Luke Lindon did not compete, the only Hancock entered being those of Hancock, Calumet, Houghton and Palmsdale. The track was in good shape, having been given a surfacing of clay and rolled, and to have an ideal place for track and athletic meets. In the evening the victors and vanquished were entertained at a dancing party sponsored by the girls of the Hancock high school at the Roushou hall.

In the events first place counted five points, second, three and third place, one. Hancock won six firsts, eight seconds, six thirds. The field and track events resulted as follows:

100 yard dash, Smith Hancock, first; Edwards, Houghton, second; Johnson, Calumet, third. Time, 11 seconds.

200 yard dash, Schilling Hancock, first; Smith Hancock, second; Sewell Houghton, third. Distance, 33 feet, 4 inches.

Half mile run, McElroy Hancock, first; Campbell Hancock, second; Johnston Hancock, third. Time, 2:18 1/2.

High jump, Primidig Calumet, first; Curtis Calumet, second; Smith and Schilling Hancock tied for third. Height, five feet.

200 yard dash, James Calumet, first; Smith Hancock, second; McCann Calumet, third. Time, 23 seconds.

Hammer throw, Kellow, Calumet, first; Smith Hancock, second; Curtis Calumet, third. Distance, 80 feet.

Mile run, McElroy Hancock, first; Crane Palmsdale, second; Annie Calumet, third. Time, 4:17.

Ironad jump, Curtis Calumet, first; Schilling Hancock, second; Hoag Calumet, third. Distance, 12 feet, 9 inches.

440 yard dash, Jackson Calumet, first; Johnston Hancock, second; Campbell Hancock, third. Time, 2:15 1/2 seconds.

Discus throw, Curtis Calumet, first; Schilling Hancock, second; Primidig Calumet, third. Distance, 35 feet 8 1/2 inches.

Two mile run, McElroy Hancock, first; Crane Palmsdale, second; Wivett Hancock, third. Time, 10:40 1/2.

Pole vault, Fryer Houghton, first; Schilling Hancock, second; Smith Hancock, third. Height, 7 feet, 10 inches.

The relay race of a half mile was easily won from Hancock by the Calumet team.
