**ASHLEY BLACKLER IS BEST ALL-AROUND ATHLETE.**

Gymnasium Rooms Packed For Final Meet of Indoor Classes.

That parents are interested in the gymnasium work of the First Methodist church gymnasium classes was seen Friday evening in the final meet of the indoor classes this season. Boys' events—3-lap run, 1st, Ashley Blackler, 18½ seconds; 2nd, D. Manville, 18 2-5 seconds; 3rd, Stickney, 18 3-5 seconds.

Broad Jump—Manville, 14' 5"; Blackler, 1' 2"; Jewell, 14' 1".

High Jump—Blackler 4'; Stickney, 3' 11"; Manville and K. Raymer tie, 3' 9".

Ten-lap Run—Blackler 1' 9". Manville 1' 11.3-5". Winner, Blackler, 15 points. Second, Manville, 12; third, Stickney, 5.

Young Men—3-lap run, Harry Moats 18', Emerson 18 4-5, D. Raymer and Wm. Lowe, tie, 19½'. High jump, R. Carley, 4' 7", Emerson 4' 6", H. Moats 4' 4". High dive, Wm. Lowe 4' 11", Moats 4' 10", Emerson 4' 6". Winner, Moats, 9 points; Emerson, 7 and W. Lowe 6 points.

Girls' Events—15-yard dash, 1st Lucile Naylor, Lucile Applegate and Ruby Tauner. Standing broad jump, Irene Nichols 6' 2", Lucile Applegate 5' 6", L. Naylor 5' 5". High jump, Tauner 3' 6", Nichols 3' 5", Myra Wyzent, 3' 4". 5-lap run, Tauner 35', Florence Frask 35 3-5', Applegate 36 4-5'. Winners, 1st Tauner, 11 points; 2nd, Nichols, 8 points; 3rd, Applegate, 7 points.
